I hope you have enjoyed some time to relax and re-charge over the summer.

Our Academy staff team is fully prepared and very much looking forward to welcoming all our S1 and S2 students to Winchburgh Academy on Tuesday 15th August.

All students have their new timetable. S1 students received their timetable in their S1 Welcome Booklet, emailed to all parents/carers prior to the holidays and they will be provided with another copy of it on Tuesday morning. S1

We have arranged a brief Welcome Assembly for S1 students and we are inviting up to two parents/carers to accompany them. The morning arrangements are as follows:

There will be photograph opportunities throughout the morning and we are looking forward to seeing all our S1 students smartly dressed in line with our formal dress code for the day (please refer to the uniform/dress code leaflet emailed previously or on the school website).

As part of the S1 Welcome Assembly, students will be called to the front of the Theatre, one by one to receive their welcome pack which includes a gym (drawstring) bag, water bottle, some stationery items, a key ring and a Winchburgh Academy pin badge. Inside the pack, all students will also receive an allocated locker key, free of charge. Staff will cover all locker arrangements with students later in the morning.

S2

We look forward to welcoming all our S2 students back to our Academy on Tuesday 15th August at the normal time of 8.40am where they will attend Personal Support & Registration (PSR) as normal before heading to their first learning workshop (period) at 8.50am. As our most senior students, we always appreciate their help and support in 'setting the highest standards' and being role models for our new S1 students. Thank you to all parents/carers for your support in ensuring that all students attend in full formal dress code (including all black footwear) on the first day of the new session.

S2 students will be invited to the Theatre at 10.10am to join our S1 students for a full school assembly. Mr. Mitchell and Mr. Kerr will take this opportunity to share some important and supportive information at this point of the morning before enjoying morning interval at the normal time of 10.30am.



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All students (S1 & S2) will report to their PSR area immediately after interval before being accompanied to their next class by their teacher and they will follow their normal timetable from there for the remainder of the day.

Netbooks/IT Devices

Our state of the art school enables us to access high speed/high quality Wi-Fi throughout the building, safely controlled in line with West Lothian Council policy and practice. Almost all of our learning will be accessed via Microsoft Teams/OneNote. This is fundamental for supporting young people with additional support needs and ensuring consistent, inclusive pedagogy across the whole school.

We have a Netbook available in school for every young person throughout next session.
