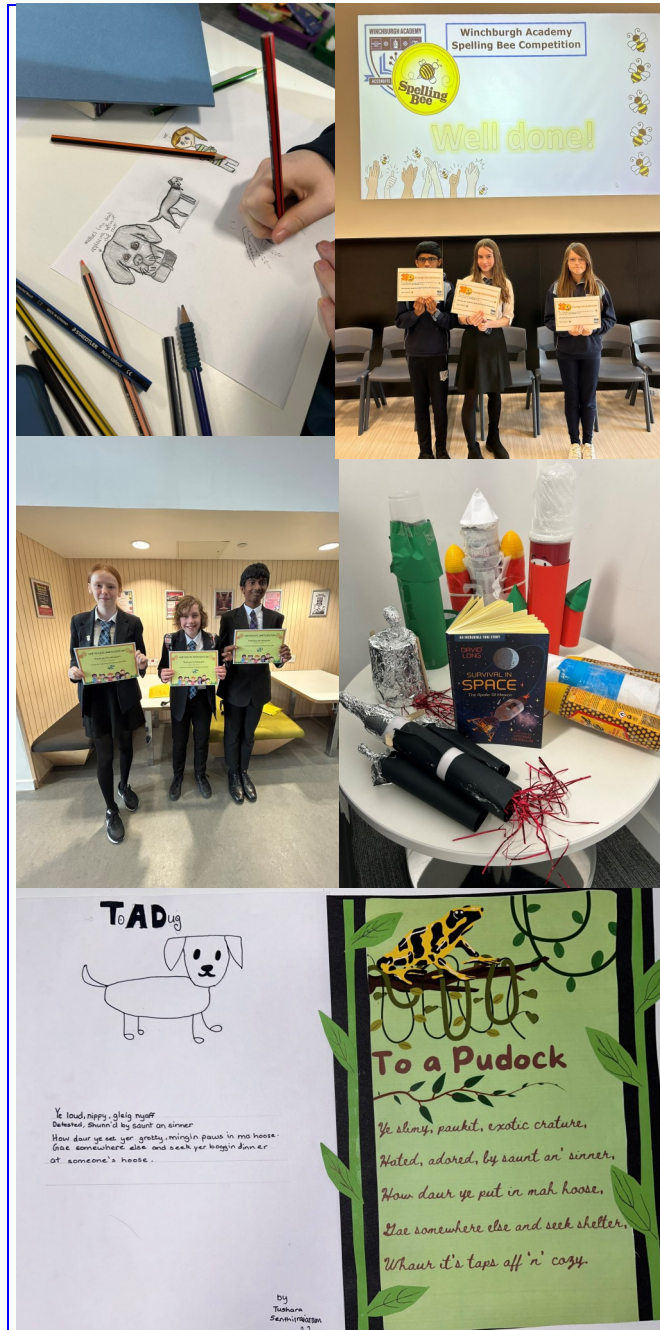
Celebrating Success

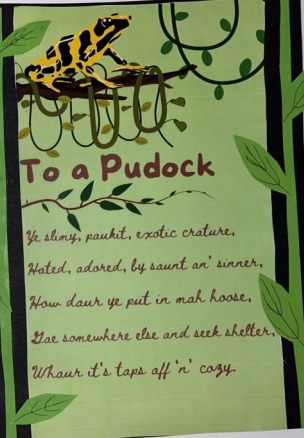
