

S2 Dalguise Residential Experience – Thursday 14th – Friday 15th May 2026

Dear Parent/Carer,

As an important part of our S2 programme of experiences, all S2 students are supported to engage in a one night/2-day, residential camp designed to further strengthen a variety of vital life (meta) skills including creativity, collaboration, leadership and developing initiative.

This is an experience that we strongly encourage all S2 students to be part of. It builds on prior learning experiences across the BGE (P1 – S3) providing a clear pathway for young people including P7 Camp, S1 Activity Days into this S2 Residential. Thereafter, many students are likely to continue into courses such as Duke of Edinburgh in S3 and beyond into the senior phase (S4-6).

The S2 Residential will take place in partnership with PGL at their Dalguise Outdoor Centre in Perthshire – the link below will take you to their website for you to get an indication of what to expect.

Although we will communicate further nearer the time, including a parent information evening, S2 students would arrive at school at an agreed, slightly earlier time on Thursday 14th May before being transported via bus to the centre to enjoy a day and night of activities, accompanied by relevant school staff including a member of the School Leadership Team. They would stay over with all meals provided, enjoy further activities on Friday 15th May before returning to school at approximately 4pm.

The total cost is £182 per student. All payments for the trip are to be made through IPay Impact (S2 Residential 2026), available from 10am on Monday 3rd November. All payments must be paid in full by Friday 20th March 2026. Payment approaches are set up to be entirely flexible to meet individual needs, some may choose to pay up a monthly sum, others may wish to pay in full at some point – please arrange what suits you best.

In the email that you received this letter you will find a direct link to allow payments to be made through IPay Impact. If you do not receive the link or have any issues opening it, please contact the school office and we will be delighted to help.

We are always able to discuss and consider other options on an individual basis to support payment plans. Please do not hesitate to contact us at school at the earliest opportunity if we can help in any way - our aim is to fully support all S2 students to attend.
